

Terms & Conditions

Please read these Terms & Conditions carefully before accessing or using our website. If you do not agree to all the terms and conditions of this agreement, then you may not access the website or use any Services.

These terms and conditions are the contract between you and BFAM Crafts ("us", "we", etc). By visiting or using crafts.bfam.co.uk, you agree to be bound by them. Our affiliates, service providers may also impose additional terms and conditions to which your contract with them will be subject.

Definitions

"BFAM Crafts", "we", "us"	means all the hardware, software and personal responsible for the operations and safe use of <u>crafts.bfam.co.uk</u>
"Site"	In respect to operations within our domain and control refers to crafts.bfam.co.uk
"Member", "Customer"	Someone who has provided personal identifiable information about themselves by creating an account or opting into specific services.
"Guest"	Someone who has provided the minimum amount of information required to utilise a function of the system for which data is only stored for the minimum practicable period required to fulfil the requirement.
"Content"	means the textual, visual or aural content that is encountered as part of your experience on crafts.bfam.co.uk . It may include, among other things: text, images, sounds, videos and animations. It includes content Posted by members.
"Post"	means any upload, content or material visible on the site by members, guests or us be it moderated or unmoderated.
"Product"	means any item offered for sale on this site
"Service"	means any service we provide directly and in the case of a third party or an affiliation these will identifiable and indicated appropriately.

Our Contract

- To enter into an agreement you must be of an age that is legally able to enter into a binding contract. (Currently 18yrs old for the U.K.)

- These terms and conditions regulate the business relationship between you and us.
- If you use this website, you do so in accordance with these terms.
 If you are unable to accept these terms, your only remedy is to leave the website.
- We may change this agreement in any way at any time.
 - For users that have setup an account with us, you will be notified via email when a change occurs.
 - For Guests and general browsers it is your responsibility to ensure you keep yourself up to date.
- We reserve the right to refuse Service to anyone for any reason at anytime.

Your account and personal information

- Upon any visit to the site, you accept responsibility for all things undertaken by any person in your name or under you account and password.

- All product prices on the site are published as G.B.P. unless otherwise stated and total price upon checkout will be displayed and based on those readily available to us at the time. We are not responsible for additional conversion charges applied by you own financial institutions.
- We do not hold any credit card information related to accounts or persons other than transactional information.
 All transactions are made securely by reputable payment gateways such as Stripe, Google Pay, Apple Pay, PayPal and it is your responsibility to adhere to any policies and procedures that they have on place and the information you provide us is comparable to theirs. Content Restrictions

We invite you to Post Content on BFAM Crafts in several ways and for different purposes, however we do have to protect our business, staff and all users of the site and also comply with the law.

These provisions apply yo all users of the site.

We do not undertake to moderate or check every item Posted, but we do protect our business vigorously and if we believe Content Posted breaches the law we shall report and fully co-operate with any law enforcement authorities in whatever ways we can.

You agree that you will not use or allow anyone else to Post Content or undertake any activity which is or may:

- be unlawful or tend to incite another person to commit a crime;
- consist in commercial audio, video or music files;
- be obscene, offensive, threatening, violent, malicious or defamatory;
- be sexually explicit or pornographic;
- promote discrimination or animosity to any person on grounds of gender,
 race, religion, nationality, disability, sexual orientation or age;

- be likely to deceive any person or be used to impersonate any person, or to misrepresent your identity, age or affiliation with any person;
- give the impression that it emanates from us or that you are connected with us or that we have endorsed you or your business;
- be made on behalf of some other person, or impersonate another person;
- use a Posting to solicit responses unconnected with the purpose of BFAM
 Crafts or the terms proposed by this agreement;
- request or collect passwords or other personal information from another user without their permission, nor Post any unnecessary personal information about yourself;
- be used to sell any goods or services or for any other commercial use not intended by us, for yourself or for any other person. Examples are: sending private messages with a commercial purpose, or collecting information with the intention of passing it to a third party for his commercial use;

- use distribution lists that include people who have not given specific permission to be included in such distribution process;
- consist in posting excessive or repeated off-topic messages;
- send age-inappropriate communications or Content to anyone under the age of 18;

Your Posting: restricted content

In connection with the restrictions set out below, we may refuse or edit or remove a Posting which does not comply with these terms.

In addition to the restrictions set out above, a Posting must not contain:

- any personal information including your name, contact details and addresses;
- hyperlinks, other than those specifically authorised by us;
- · keywords or words repeated, which are irrelevant to the Content Posted;
- the name, logo or trademark of any organisation other than yours;
- · inaccurate, false, or misleading information;
- material or links to material that exploits people in a sexual, violent or other manner, or solicits personal information from anyone under 18 years old;

Removal of offensive content

For the avoidance of doubt, this paragraph is addressed to any person who interacts with BFAM Crafts for any purpose.

We are under no obligation to monitor or record the activity of any user of BFAM Crafts for any purpose, nor do we assume any responsibility to monitor or police Internet-related activities. However, we may do so without notice to you and without giving you a reason.

If you are offended by any Content, the following procedure applies:

- your claim or complaint must be submitted to us using the contact us form available on BFAM Crafts, or via post or email containing the same information as that requested in our form.
- we shall remove the offending Content as soon as we are reasonably able;
- after we receive notice of a claim or complaint, we shall investigate so far as we alone decide;
- we may re-instate the Content about which you have complained or we may not;
- In respect of any complaint made by you or any person on your behalf, whether using our form of complaint or not, you now irrevocably grant to us a licence to publish the complaint and all ensuing correspondence and communication, without limit;
- you now agree that if any complaint is made by you frivolously or vexatiously you will repay us the cost of our investigation including legal fees, if any.

Copyright or Other Intellectual Property Rights

- If any term or provision of this agreement is at any time held by any jurisdiction to be void, invalid or unenforceable, then it shall be treated as changed or reduced, only to the extent minimally necessary to bring it within the laws of that jurisdiction and to prevent it from being void and it shall be

binding in that changed or reduced form. Subject to that, each provision shall be interpreted as severable and shall not in any way affect any other of these terms.

- For the purposes of the Data Protection Act 1998 you consent to the processing of your personal data (in manual, electronic or any other form) relevant to this agreement, by us [and/or any agent or third party nominated by us] [and bound by a duty of confidentiality]. Processing includes but is not limited to obtaining, recording, using and holding data and includes the transfer of data to any country in any part of the World.
- If you are in breach of any term of this agreement, we may:
 - publish all text and Content relating to the claimed breach, including your name and email address and all correspondence between us and our respective advisers; and you now irrevocably give your consent to such publication;
 - terminate your account and refuse access to BFAM Crafts;
 - remove or edit Content, or cancel any order at our discretion;
 - issue a claim in any court.
- Any obligation in this agreement intended to continue to have effect after termination or completion shall so continue.
- No failure or delay by any party to exercise any right, power or remedy will operate as a waiver of it nor indicate any intention to reduce that or any other right in the future.
- When you visit BFAM Crafts or send messages to us by email, you are communicating with us electronically. We communicate with you by e-mail or by posting notices on BFAM Crafts. You agree that all our electronic communications satisfy any legal requirement that such communications be in writing
- Any communication to be served on either of us by the other shall be delivered by hand or sent by first class post or recorded delivery or by e-mail.
